



SLIPWAY USAGE AND RULES!

Use of the slipway and the associated amenities and facilities are strictly at own risk. Please note that our slipway is unsupervised. Immediately remove your trailer after launching your boat from the slipway.

- ONLY **ONE BOAT** in the launching bay AT A TIME.
- Every person in control of a vessel above 15hp must be in possession of a valid SAMSA approved Skippers License.
- A current Gamtoos River Boat licence is required for all vessels using our slipway to launch. Failure to provide a valid license will result in no launch.
- Do not use the slipway when under the influence of drink or drugs.
- Do not overtake unless you are certain it is safe to do so. Powerboats give way to sailing vessels. Always maintain a safe and cautious speed when passing boats at anchor or when the visibility is bad or that your wake does not cause a danger to the other boat.
- Regularly inspect your safety equipment in your capsize kit and always have it available on board your boat.
- Keep just to the **right** of the centre of the river at all times.
- Always turn anti-clockwise when making U-turns.
- Operate your boat responsibly at all times with due consideration for small craft and other users of the river.
- Be aware of swimmers at all times on the river.
